The Sarah Hull Hallock Free Library (SHHFL) has launched a \$60,000 capital fundraising campaign in order to reconfigure the children's area in the Annex and refresh the 1924 historic section of the library.

SHHFL was grateful to receive a capital grant award from NY State to help consolidate the children's collection and build a new accessible circulation desk in the Annex. This grant covers work in the Annex only.

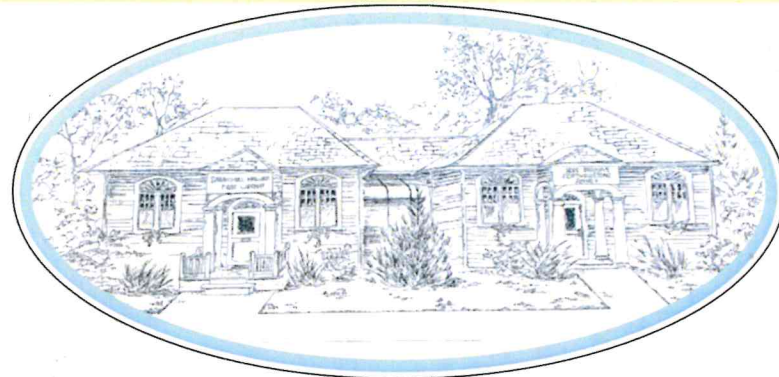
The Capital Fund Campaign extends improvements beyond the Annex to enhance the 1924 section of the library building, and its lovely details from the last century: dark woodwork, coffered ceiling, fireplace, to name a few. Plans include new carpeting, painting, energy-efficient lighting, and shelving.

The walkway is paved with customized bricks, engraved with your favorite book or author, your name or business, or in honor or memory of loved ones — it's your choice!

As you face the library from Main Street, you see the Historic Library, built in 1924, on the left. The 1990 Grace Featherstone Annex is on the right, and was built to mirror the original library. An atrium with a floor-to-ceiling window connects the twin wings.

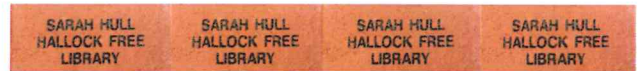
